

Who is Epuron


Epuron is an Australian-owned renewable energy company, based in Sydney, that has been developing renewable energy projects since 2003. We have successfully developed numerous wind and solar projects in NSW and across Australia.

What are we doing

We are exploring an area 40 km east of Armidale, and several km north of Wollomombi, to see if it is suitable for a wind farm. For the past 18 months, we have monitored wind in the area with positive results. We are now ready to move to the next step of creating a layout plan for a wind farm and preparing an environmental impact statement. As part of these activities, we want to hear from the community so that where possible we can incorporate your views into our plans.

Where are we investigating

The area we are exploring for a wind farm is shown in the map below as the “potential wind resource area”. The potential wind resource area has reliable and consistent winds and is located in close proximity to existing powerlines that connect to the electricity grid.



Why a wind farm

Australia is very lucky to have abundant energy resources including coal, gas, hydro, wind and the sun. Traditionally in Australia, we have used coal and gas for producing electricity. Today, wind energy is one of the cheapest forms of electricity generation. Wind energy complements our traditional electricity generation sources and makes up around 8% of the total electricity generated in Australia. We are exploring the area north of Wollomombi because we believe it has a good chance of being suitable for a wind farm with:

- reliable and consistent winds, and
- located in close proximity to powerlines that connect to the electricity grid.
